#### PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

- PROGRAM IS NATIONAL IN SCOPE
- Stipend and health care coverage provided in addition to tuition remission for the entire program
- High degree of flexibility
- Initial 2 years for medical training, three summer laboratory rotations, and optional graduate course work
- 3-5 years of research to complete doctoral thesis
- 2 years for clinical clerkships
- Monthly meetings, seminars, journal clubs, and informal research groups

#### APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- Applicants must be US citizens or permanent residents residing in the US at the time of application
- Submit an application through AMCAS to the Medical School Office of Admissions
- Complete an MSTP application after submitting the AMCAS
- Openings for 10-14 students
